MUSIC DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Smikahl provided the Music Director Report and had the following comments on current topics.

- October 26th- Olathe Marching Festival (OMI). Mr. Smikahl and Chairs Stephanie Bowen and Kerri Church spoke about the event and planning.
 - O Focus for the next week will be to solicit local businesses to advertise in the program. Information packets were handed out to boosters in attendance and pleas were made to get out and try to encourage at least one business to buy an ad. This is a revenue and will help lower first year operating costs. Other revenue opportunities are: concessions, band entry fees, and audience entrance fees.
 - O A volunteer signup will be available and communicated this next week. It will take 150+ volunteers from OE. Parents should be hearing more soon.
 - Latest and greatest Information is available at oeband.com or in Mr. Smikahl's emails. Save the date since this event will take all parents to be successful.
 - O The goal has been met of having 13 bands sign up for the competition and we have 14 which is great for the first year.
 - OE and ONW will be performing shows as exhibition. OE will perform prior to caption awards in the afternoon approximately 4:30pm and ONW will perform prior to finals awards approximately 10:30pm.
- October 12th- Shawnee Mission North Competition. 2 performances. The first performance will be midafternoon and finals in the evening. This will be a late night. Mr. Smikahl will send out an email on 10/09.
- October 19th- KS Bandmasters Competition in Topeka. Most competitive competition of the season. Mr. Smikahl will be sending an email with all the details. OE will perform at 4:15pm. Final bands will be announced soon after. This will be the latest night of the season.
- Football Playoff Games- Keep November open for the chance of playoff games. OE will play at home games only and Friday morning rehearsals will occur.
- There are only a few rehearsals left for marching season. Heavy sighs from Senior Parents.

With the semi-trailer, we would hire a CDL driver to drive to all day competition events or BOA in St. Louis. Besides the semi-trailer costs there would be construction expenses to build out the inside of the trailer and custom painting for the outside of the trailer. The multi-level unit would hold all percussion instruments and band instruments and equipment.
