# 3<sup>rd</sup> Hour Concert Band

Next week we will get some new music as we try to determine the most effective way to teach in the hybrid schedule with unique instrumentation in each class. We are close to having the new LMS system operational and once it is I will schedule their first playing test over music we have been working on in class.

## 4<sup>th</sup> Hour Jazz Combo

Next week we will start learning some basic jazz theory and learn how to solo over chord changes instead of just using the Blues Scale. Students have access to a play-along-track that they can use to practice their improvising while playing with a virtual rhythm section.

#### 7th Hour Concert Band Percussion Class

With our in person students we have been working very hard on mallets and are close to having all 12 major scales learned. Virtual students are learning different warm-up exercises in the drumline packet. They have been assigned Monster Bucks for next week.

### Marching Band and Drumline 1st and 2nd Hours

As I mentioned in an earlier email this week, we are hosting a playoff game this week. Report time for the students in 5:00 p.m. at OE so we can rehearse. I plan to end the rehearsal by 6:00 p.m. so students can get out to the stadium around 6:30 p.m. If this plan causes transportation challenges please let me know and we can excuse your student from the rehearsal. Leadership team students need to report at 4:45 p.m. so we can have short meeting. Once again, students need to wear their dry fit shirt, jeans, and tennis shoes but they can wear as many layers under as they want and they can bring a coat, gloves, and a hat. For this game the parent tickets will still work. If you lost your tickets and were added to the admit list last week your name will still be on the list. Please email me if you need added to that list. We are playing the lowest ranked seed in the bracket so there is a very good chance we will win on Friday night. If we win we would host another playoff game next week and would perform at it. For the game next week parents would be required to purchase tickets.

#### **District Band Auditions**

I sent information to student emails today about the process for getting me recordings so I can load them on the audition site. I will need those by Tuesday so that I can have them loaded by the deadline on Wednesday. They are not accepting any late auditions so it will be very important for students to take care of this over the weekend. Students should read the instructions very carefully to make sure they are performing the correct portions of the material and following all of the recording rules.
