Parents:

We have a very important event coming up that we really need help with. Every year we hold a Bingo event that is the primary funding for next year's halftime show. As many of you have already heard, this year I received the largest budget cut to my building budget that I have had in my 22 years of teaching. This means that this event is even more critical than it has ever been to the future success of the Orange and Blue Brigade.

As I shared with every class in the last two days, I am never excited to talk about fundraising. It is certainly not why I went into teaching music. However, the reality of the current situation in our State is that education budgets continue to be cut and the only way to fund some aspects of our program is to hold successful fundraisers. First place finishes in our division at two different contests, multiple caption awards, and our first One Rating at the Bands of America Super Regional in St. Louis this year were the results of a lot of hard work by the students and staff. However, a large part of our success was the custom show that was written specifically to highlight the strengths of our program both musically and visually. In order to continue to have the success we have had in the past we need to raise enough funds to pay for the custom show and props for next year.

We are in need of assistance in two ways. First, we need help soliciting donations. At the Bingo event the winner of each game of bingo wins a gift basket full of donated item. We are way behind on collecting donations for this portion of the event. Below is a link detailing what we need.

Second, we will need some volunteers to help actually run the event. More information will be available on that at a later date.

Finally, we need every family to try to sell tickets to the event. Many families have made it a family event and had a lot of fun. It has also been a great opportunity to get grandparents and neighbors involved as well. We have even had some families reach out to friends that will have students in the band program next year and encourage them to come to the event and start getting plugged in to the high school. We don't require students to sell a specific number of tickets but if a majority of the families in the program could sell at least two tickets we would be able to fund our show for next year.

The other aspect I spoke with the students about in class is utilizing our resources better as a booster organization. If you have connections either through work or through friends or family that could result in donated items for the event please let us know.
