### MUSIC DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Mr. Smikahl provided the Music Director Report and had the following comments on current topics.

- Thank you to all parents that contributed their time and efforts for the Orange & Blue BBQ and Lincoln Test
  Drive which were both successful. Parents need to continue to sign up for Groom and Plume Chaperones,
  Hospitality, and Crew. Mr. Smikahl supported the boosters in requesting the parents to get involved in any way
  possible. Running an aggressive program like ours is not possible without our parent volunteers.
- We are now ¾ through the marching season with the last ⅓ being competitions. Students have been working hard and making great progress.
- Although not Mr. Smikahl's favorite event- the Old Settlers Day Parade went very well and complimented the students on their playing.
- For the first time ever, the band will NOT be performing pre-game this season.
- Individual Football game performances are still being discussed as to whether the band will perform the show before or after the game.
- September 13th- Report time will be 5:00pm and buses will load at 5:30pm. The band will only perform the Opener and the Ballad not the Closer as details are still being worked on.
- September 21st- Parent Preview of Creep Crawl Slither Shed.
- September 26th- Senior Parent Night. Order of events and performances are still being determined.
- September 30th- Olathe District Marching Festival at CBAC. OE will be performing first.
- October 4th- Homecoming and Glow Show. Order of events: Show will be performed before the game,
   Homecoming Court will be at half-time, and Glow Show after the game.
- October 5th- Smith Cotton Competition in Sedalia. First time OE has attended this event. There will be one
  performance of the show mid-morning (TBD on time), Clinic early afternoon, and then band will board the bus
  and head home early giving students some extra time to prepare for Homecoming. Mr. Smikahl requests
  marchers participate in clinic since this is one of the advantages of this event.
- October 12th- Shawnee Mission North Competition. 2 performances. The first performance will be midafternoon and finals in the evening. This will be a late night.
- October 19th- KS Bandmasters Competition in Topeka. Most competitive competition of the season.
- October 26th- Olathe Marching Festival (OMI).
  - O The goal has been met of having 13 bands sign up for the competition which is great for the first year.
  - There will be programs with advertising available so, reach out and try to find advertisers. Other revenue opportunities are: concessions, entry fees, and audience entrance fees.
  - O OE and ONW will be performing shows as exhibition. TBD who will perform when.
  - A committee is in place and parents should be hearing more soon. Save the date since this event will take all parents to be successful.
- Football Playoff Games- Keep the end of October and November open for the chance of playoff games. OE will play at home games only.

The multi-level unit would hold all percussion instruments and band instruments and equipment.
