Marching Band and Drumline Classes

- We have received our bell covers and performance masks and will begin weekly Monday night rehearsals on Monday,
 September 21st! These rehearsals will run from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m. Students need to bring a mask, their instrument, a flip folder and a lyre for their instrument. Flip folders and lyres are available for purchase at Meyer Music if you do not have one. We have very few opportunities to try to put some music together to perform. Attendance will be critical for these rehearsals.

Concert Band

We are starting instruction on the circle of fourths, which is fundamental to everything that we do in band at Olathe East. Students that have had the class before should be in very good shape. Students that are new to OE should not hesitate to reach out to Mrs. Creek or myself if you need additional help. This information builds on itself so it will get increasing difficult for students that fall behind early.

Jazz Combo

We have continued to learn strategies and tips for improving their improvisation. We also have done a lot of listening lessons. I am going to ask all members of the class to submit a video next week of themselves soloing on our current chart using the play along recording that has been loaded into the LMS.

7th Hour Percussion Class

We have introduced all of the paradiddle rudiment varitions and students submitted a video of themselves playing the Paradiddle Pyramid as their first playing test. They are not working on all of the flam rudiments on the PAS rudiment sheet that is loaded in the LMS.
