Band Letter Policy

Standards for a band letter are purposefully kept very high to encourage continued musical growth, commitment, and volunteerism among the group's members. Students must meet these criteria to receive a letter in band:

Must be an enrolled member in good standing of Marching Band, Symphonic Band, and/or Wind Ensemble for the entire year.

Must maintain an A or better average in all band classes.

Must have <u>no</u> unexcused performance absences for the year.

Must earn 150 letter points through the following:

- 50—Audition for the KMEA District I Honor Band
- 50—Be accepted in, and perform with KMEA District I Honor Band or John Philip Sousa Honor Band
- 50—Audition for, and perform with, All-State Band/Orchestra (requires successful KMEA District Audition)
- 50—Perform a solo or participate in an ensemble at the Regional Solo & Ensemble Festival
- 50—Participate in State Solo & Ensemble Festival (requires I rating at Regional Solo & Ensemble Festival)
- 100—Participate with perfect attendance in Pep Band, having no more than 2 subs for the season
- 25—Participate with perfect attendance in Pit Orchestra
- 25—Hold performing membership in Jazz Band for the entire year
- 20—Hold full-term membership in Youth Symphony or similar organization (church ensemble, etc.), as defined by the organization, performing on your band instrument.
- 20—Private lessons on your band instrument
- 5—Pep Band sub (5 pts per game)
