Next Concert

The next concert is the Area Festival on Tuesday, February 11th and will include students in hours 1 through 4 as well as students from PT and CT. There will be a few students in the 7th hour percussion class that will perform, but not very many of them. It will be held in the gym and seating will be limited so plan to arrive early for the best seats. Report time will be 6:40 p.m. for the students. For this concert there will be combined rehearsal 7:00 a.m. Tuesday, February 4th and Tuesday, February 11th for students in first, third, and a few students in 7th hour.

Thanks

Huge thanks to everyone that participated and planned the Basket Bingo event. It was once again an amazing success! We are excited to move forward with our plans for next year's show now that we have covered those costs. I plan to make a show announcement sometime before spring break once we finish up a few details.

Help Needed

As I have mentioned in previous emails, our very large and successful senior class has a lot of parents that are filling important positions within the booster program right now and will need their positions filled soon. We have filled a few important positions so far, but we still have a few that are open that are critical to the success of the entire band program. We need to vote the new board in during the April meeting so it is crucial that we find parents to fill those positions as soon as possible. Tuesday, February 4th at 7:000 p.m. in the band room we will have a booster meeting. If you are willing to consider stepping up your involvement in the program and would like more information please consider attending that meeting. On a personal note, as my oldest daughter enters the band program next year at Olathe West I plan to volunteer with their booster program as much as my schedule allows. That coupled with the fact that next year is our large trip year really increases the need for booster assistance so that we keep everything running smoothly in the program.

Percussion Trip to Indianapolis

I have our preliminary schedule for the trip from BOA. I plan to have a short trip meeting immediately following the booster meeting on Tuesday night to go over some additional trip details.

Next Year's Trip

As many of you know, we take a major trip every three years. We take concert trips so that every student in the program that wants to attend the trip can, even if they are not in marching band. I am actively working with a tour organizer to plan next year's major trip. As soon as we have plans finalized I will schedule a mandatory trip meeting that will be held in the auditorium. I anticipate that meeting not being held until after spring break. More information to come on this subject.

Marching Band Camp

I have usually finalized camp dates for marching band by this point of the year. However, we have some unique challenges this summer that are making the process slower. As soon as I have the dates finalized I will send a separate email with those dates. A reminder for parents who have students marching for the first time next year, we have a mandatory camp at the beginning of June and the end of July. We learn approximately 60% of the show at the camps so it is critical that students attend. Please email me with any specific schedule concerns.
