There have been a lot of questions about plans for BOA. I will try to answer as many as possible in this email. We collected rooming sheets from students in class today. Then I will have a better idea of how many rooms we have available for chaperones and will try to ask parents and get that finalized in the next few days. Once I am done with that I will send out information on the hotel we are using.
